



## CLIENT CONSENT AND BILL OF RIGHTS

- Massage therapy received by Eva Branson of Sacred Lotus is for general wellness purposes, including stress reduction, relief from muscular tension or spasms, promotion of lymph and blood circulation, and flexibility.
- The therapist will never touch genitals, breast tissue, or any other areas I instruct them not to touch.
- For conditions that fall outside of the massage therapist's scope of practice, the massage therapist may refer or recommend to me the most appropriate option to consult regarding care or treatment options. I also have the option to see another appropriate health care provider, including a physician, for diagnosis or treatment of any suspected medical problems.
- It is my responsibility to inform the massage therapist of any existing medical conditions that I may have and keep the massage therapist informed of any changes in my health and medications in the future.
- I understand the risks of massage include mild short-term muscle soreness due to movement of irritating metabolic waste and/or mild surface level bruising.
- I have the right to refuse massage therapy treatment at any time during the session.
- If I experience any pain or discomfort during a body-work session, I will immediately inform the therapist so that the procedure can be adjusted to my level of comfort.
- I have stated all medical conditions, both physical and mental, of which I am aware and I agree to keep my therapist updated as to any changes in my medical profile.
- Unless other arrangements are made with Eva Branson of Sacred Lotus, I agree to make payment in full at the time of service.
- Cancelled or missed appointments without 24 hours of notice (medical emergencies excluded) will be charged in full for the price of the missed session and shall be solely my responsibility.
- I authorize the performance of massage therapy/body-work techniques and procedures and understand what I will receive from them. I understand that treatment may be refused or stopped if I appear obviously intoxicated, under the influence of drugs, or if I make any inappropriate, illicit, or sexually suggestive remarks or advances toward the therapist, and that I will be liable for payment of the scheduled appointment.
